## CANADA TO WURTTEMBERG - 1846 and 1854



1846 – Canada to Wurttemberg Prepaid – Prepaid to New York – By Private Ship to France and Postage Collect from France.



1854 – Canada to Wurttemberg Collect – Via Cunard Steamer by Closed Bag to Britain via the United States and via France – With a – *CANADA &c ART. 12.* – Handstamp.

# CANADA to GREAT BRITAIN - 1846 and 1855



1846 – Niagara, U.C. to England via Toronto and Montreal per Cunard Steamer via Boston – Closed Bag Mail as a Money Letter.



1855 – Toronto to England – Registered in Canada and Prepaid – Charged 6d. Collect Registration Fee in Britain – No direct Registration all the way at this time.

## IONIAN ISLANDS to CANADA and NEWFOUNDLAND - 1846 and 1857



1846 – Corfu, Ionian Islands to Canada via Britain with a Corfu Paid Crown Circle – Rated 2/2 Stg. Prepaid – Corfu to Canada.



1857 – Zante, Ionian Islands to Newfoundland via Austria, Prussia, Belgium and Britain – Total Postage 1/8½ NFLD. Money Collect – (1/8 plus ½d Local Charge or Exchange).

# NEWFOUNDLAND to UNITED STATES and ENGLAND - 1847

- PAID AT ST. JOHN'S NEWFOUNDLAND - Crown Circles on covers from St. John's to Boston, U.S.A. and to Sunbury, England.







1847 - Prince Edward Island to France - Prepaid 2/10 Stg. - Via Halifax and London per Cunard Steamer.



1848 – Prince Edward Island to France – 15 Decimes Collect – Via Halifax and London per Cunard Steamer with a – CANADA &c ART 12 – Anglo-French Accountancy Handstamp.

### CANADA to MADEIRA ISLANDS and VENEZUELA - 1847 and 1851



May 26, 1847 – Montreal, Canada to Madeira via London – Prepaid via Forwarding Agent. Endorsed – *Pr. West India Mail Steamer.* – Per Cunard British Steamer – *Britannia* – 31st voyage.



November 18, 1851 – Guelph, U.C. to Caracas, Venezuela – Prepaid via Halifax – 3d Cy – To Halifax plus 4d Stg. –  $4\frac{1}{2}$  Cy – Packet Rate per Cunard Steamer to British Post Office, St. Thomas, Danish West Indies and Collect Postage from St. Thomas.

# CANADA to TUSCANY and SARDINIA - 1847 and 1856



1847 – Quebec to London – Prepaid to London and Forwarded via France and Sardinia to Tuscany.



1858 – Hamilton, C.W. to London – Prepaid to Sardinia via U.S.A., Britain and France – Collect with the – *CANADA ART•19* – Anglo-French Accountancy Handstamp in red.



1847 – Penang, Malaya to Canada via England – Per P+O and Cunard Steamers with Postage Collect.



1857 – Canada to Shanghai, China via England, Marseilles and Hong Kong – Prepaid 1/2 Stg. to England and 1/5 Stg. Collect England to Shanghai – Per Cunard Steamer via Boston and through France – Via P+O Steamers *Valetta*, *Hindostan* and *Pekin* to Hong Kong and Steamer *Formosa* – Hong Kong to Shanghai.

# NEW BRUNSWICK to UNITED STATES - 1848 and 1862

- Both covers from St. John, New Brunswick to New York carried by Express Companies.



This cover was carried by AMES & CO'S EXPRESS to Boston and posted there.



This cover was carried by TURNER'S AMERICAN EXPRESS to New York.



1849 – Lahaina, Maui, Sandwich Islands to New Brunswick via California – Around Cape Horn via New Bedford, Mass. and overland to Fredericton.



1849 – Sacramento, California to Montreal via New York – Rated PAID 40 ¢ – California to east coast U.S.A. –plus 4 ½ d Canada Postage Collect – Gold Rush Cover – Description of overland journey to California from Salt Lake City, Utah.



1849 – Scotland to New Brunswick – Postage Collect per Cunard Steamer using a *Valentine's* Ocean Penny Postage Envelope – State 3.



1850 – Lowell, Mass., U.S.A. to Pictou, Nova Scotia via New Brunswick with a two line – ST. JOHN • N•B SHIP LETTER – Handstamp.



1849 – Grand Bank, Newfoundland to London via Forwarding Agent – A. ROGERSON & SON ST. JOHN'S N.F.LAND – The only strike reported in *Pratt. Ex. Pratt Page 108*.



1849 – New Brunswick to an officer in the Crimea via *Army Agent Cox & Co.* in London – Prepaid with the uncommon New Brunswick – *BRITISH 5d CLAIM* – red accountancy handstamp. This is probably to a New Brunswicker in the Imperial Army in the Crimea.

## VANCOUVER ISLAND to BRITAIN and FRANCE - 1849 and 1861



1849 – Beaver Harbour, (Fort Rupert), Vancouver Island per Hudson's Bay Co. Ship around Cape Horn to Britain. Beaver Harbour was at the top end of Vancouver Island – From a Hudson's Bay Co. clerk.



1861 – Victoria to France via San Francisco and New York – With two strikes of the • POST OFFICE• VICTORIA V.I. – Arms Handstamp.



1850 – Canada to India via Cox & Co. – Army Agents – Missent to Hong Kong with a Hong Kong red manuscript – *Missent to* – marking, according to the Hong Kong Study Circle, the <u>only</u> such early Hong Kong – Missent to – marking recorded.



1855 – Canada to Tasmania Prepaid via Britain – <u>Very few</u> Canada Pence Period covers recorded to Tasmania.

## CHILE to NEW BRUNSWICK and NOVA SCOTIA - 1851 and 1852



1851 – Constitucion, Chile to New Brunswick via Panama and New York Forwarding Agents – With a – ST. JOHN•N•B• – Handstamp. And a St. John, N.B. small 3 Handstamp – <u>Unrecorded</u> in *JG* & *Y*.



1852 – Valparaiso, Chile to Nova Scotia via Valparaiso, and Boston Forwarding Agents via New York.



1852 – Quebec to France with CANADA & ART 12 Anglo-French Accountancy Handstamp. Collect with the QUEBEC – CAN. Datestamp, believed to be the <u>only known strike</u> at present.



1853 – Quebec to France with COLONIES & ART 13 Anglo-French Accountancy Handstamp. Per the Canadian Steam Navigation Co. chartered steamer – Lady Eglinton – made only two voyages – Return portion maiden voyage for C.S.N. Co.
