METER STAMP SOCIETY TOWN LIST

A Canada Town List is published by Alan Draves, Box 190, New Knoxville, Ohio, USA ZIP 45871. It attempts to list all basic towns where meters have been identified in Canada. These are listed in editions of the METER STAMP BULLETIN. Spellings are those used in the Canada Postal Directory up to 1980/81. These are not always the spelling used on the meter town mark. Actual TM spellings are used for discontinued post offices where known. No postal stations, branches, errors or varieties are included. Punctuation and province/territory abbreviation varieties are not listed.

The list is maintained on a computer data set to permit periodic updates and additions. Supplements appear in the Meter Stamp Bulletin. Copies are available from Mr. Draves at a cost of 75 cents US (I suggest you make it \$1 to cover postage as well). The MSS would welcome reports of towns not listed in this publication. Contributors are identified by name in their Bulletin. EXACT spelling and meter number should be reported.

The above material is extracted from the introduction to this 9 page publication; I would urge you to get one - it is interesting. This is a good spot to also urge CMSG members to join the MSS of the USA. Their most recent Bulletin has a feature article on new FRIDEN meter varieties. My thanks to Alan Draves for a complimentary copy of the most recent Bulletin and the Town List he maintains.

NOTES

As mentioned above, Friden Company has introduced a new series of Electronic Meters. These have a new design similar to type 21.4 but with the line of maple leaves at far right similar to type 21.3. Serial numbers start with 380000; first use appears to be machine number 380003 at the Ontario Ministry of Transportation and Communication in Toronto on June 24, 1981. Several odd specimen meters of this series with US types and CITY PROVINCE townmarks were used from March-May apparently. Another meter of this new type (shall we say 21.5 in Irwin sequence??) is 380014 used at the same Ministry above. Others now are in use at Bell Canada offices in Toronto as well.

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Wilf Whitehouse notes that the style of type 11 meter numbers has changed apparently with old type numbers used up to machine 160294 and new numbers starting around 160402. Serial numbers resemble type 18 numbers. He wonders if others can shed further light on the exact changeover position. Write him at 2427 Greenfield Ave, Kamloops, B.C. V2B 4P6.

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Canadian D.A Stuart Oil Co. Limited had meter number 249353, Irwin type 14. Sometime between Aug 57 and Oct 58 they moved from Toronto to Scarborough; or at least their meter says so. These types of TM shifts are unusual and a neat find. Changes in meter ownership and changes subsequently of TM names are also hard to find. Look for them. Thanks to Ross Irwin for this note.

Mr. Andy Palochik has recently invited those of you who are not members to join the Postal History Society of Canada. This Study Group is affiliated with the PHSC and financially supported by it with a recent grant. I would urge all of you to consider joining. 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An interesting aspect of meter collecting is town and date varieties. Previously I discussed town spelling errors - has anyone some to report?? Ross Irwin has kindly included a page (3-4) examining date varieties on type 7.3 meters. Keep a sharp eye out - these are not as obvious as they sometimes appear.

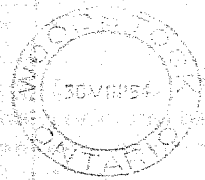

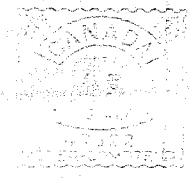

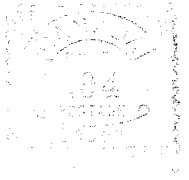
Model R datemark with DMY as used in 1949 when bilingual datemark established. Irwin 7.3.10



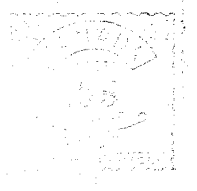
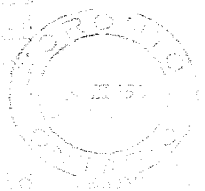
Midget datemark, Irwin 7.3.9, as used in 1949 for bilingual meters

CANADIAN MILITARY METERS

Postage meters are in widespread use across Canada at military bases, stations, recruiting centres, Dept. of National Defence offices and Canadian bases in foreign countries. An initial survey indicates that there have been at least 327 different meter machines placed in service with the earliest date observed being JAN 22, 1943 used at London Ontario. During 1943-45 three special meters were used at POW Camps in Canada at Monteith Ontario and Lethbridge and Medicine Hat in Alberta. These are likely the rarest of Canadian military meters. What are military meters worth? Large lots are frequently available at dealers such as Wegg's in Toronto. These may be entire or cuts and sell for about \$10 for 50 items (20 cents each). These include current and more common military meters from a source within DND. On the other hand, the POW meter examples mentioned above may sell for up to \$100 each. Scarcer items such as NPO, CAPO, CFPO, FMO and RCAF STATION meters sell for \$5-10 each in most cases.

Twelve Irwin type 7 meter machines have been reported, with 7 only used during the 1943-46 period and 5 later from 1953-57. One rebuilt machine is a type 7.5 (No. 04004) used at NPO 617 in Cornwallis, NS. An unusual machine was No. 82717 with the townmark ST JOHN'S QUEBEC later changed to RCAF STN ST JEAN QUEBEC on about January 1, 1956.

Several meter types are much more widespread at Canadian military establishments than others. The most common is Pitney Bowes model R (Irwin type 11) with about 100 machines introduced since 1943. All appear to be type 11.1 with the one exception of machine no. 155971 used at DND HQ in Ottawa, a type 11.2. At least nine of these machines were used during WWII at Montreal, Ottawa(3), London, Victoria(2) and Halifax(2). Another 31 machines were introduced between 1947-59 and 32 were apparently only used from 1960-63. Introduction of annual bulk mail procedures for government departments at the beginning of 1964, saw the withdrawal of meters in government offices including all military bases. However, a few machines remained in use into 1964 and possibly up to 1967. In 1972, meters were again reintroduced into government (and military) use. At least 28 type 11 machines have come into use between 1972-79.

Less popular machine types are the Pitney Bowes model DM3 (Irwin type 14) with only three reported in the 1959-66 period at RCAF Stations in Dawson Creek and Moose Jaw and at Halifax. Only four Pitney Bowes model RT-7 (Irwin type 18) meters have been reported being introduced between 1972-79 at Ottawa, Toronto, Montreal and St. Hubert. The Postalia Company of Germany has only been able to introduce three Irwin type 19 machines at Canadian Forces bases in Germany at CFPO 5000 and 5056 (machine number series 01383-01385).

About 55 Pitney Bowes model 5X (Irwin type 20) have been placed in service with the Canadian military. Of these, 17 have been used in Alberta, none in Saskatchewan and the remainder are spread across the nation. Five were used only in the 1962-63 period at RCAF Cold Lake, Camp Borden, Petawawa, Trenton and Bagotville; in 1967 one was in use at Greenwood NS apparently; the rest were introduced between 1972-79. Several have been moved. Machine no. 567643 saw use at Sept Iles up to the end of April 1972 then was used at Massey Park Quebec from May 72 onward to the present. Machine no. 564824 had a townmark reading ST JEAN from 1972-73 but was changed to read RICELAIN in Quebec by 1977. All meters of this group are Irwin type 20.1 with two exceptions noted. Type 20.2 meters were used at RCAF Cold Lake and Bushell Park (Alberta).

Twenty Friden meters (type 21) were introduced to military establishments from 1972-79. Of these, 16 are type 21.1, 3 are type 21.2 and one used in LONDON Ontario is a type 21.4. None of these meters are used in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, Quebec, New Brunswick or PEI bases.

The Neopost Company of England has been quite successful in introducing their meters to the Canadian military with 37 machines in use since 1972. One of these was an Irwin type 22.1 with the townname MUSKA, a spelling error for MUSKWA in Manitoba. The machine may have been used only for one week and then was withdrawn, a genuine meter rarity thus. Most Neopost machines are type 22.2 (20 in use) or type 22.3 (16 in use). They are popular in Quebec (10 in the province) but none are used in the Atlantic provinces. One of these machines is in use at the Canadian Defence Liaison Staff HQ in London, England at CFPO 5051.

Another common Canadian military meter is Irwin type 23 produced by Pitney Bowes with 80 machines introduced since 1972. Nineteen are in use in British Columbia, 28 in Ontario, and 14 in the Atlantic provinces. Five are in use in the Northwest Territories at Inuvik or Yellowknife. One used at EGANVILLE was changed to FOYMOUNT in Ontario at the end of 1972 (machine no. 817189).

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The lists enclosed with this article should be carefully checked against your own collection. Where (**) appear, I am quite unsure of these data such as TM spelling, dates of use or the wording and structure of slogans or return addresses. If you can send me corrections and additions, these will be incorporated into an expanded and revised PHSC Journal article in 1982. All contributions will be acknowledged. In particular, please report foreign Canadian military meters, and if they exist, use of foreign military meters in Canada (i.e. such as German Armed Forces at Shilo Base??). For interest, the table below outlines my inventory of dates of use, thus far reported for Canadian military meters.
