POST OFFICE BUILDINGS ON POSTCARDS - #1 IN A SERIES

Port Elgin

The first postcard in this series is a sepia-coloured photocard with a hand-printed title reading **POST**

OFFICE / PT ELGIN at the bottom. It shows a snowy view of a residence with a separate entrance having a POST OFFICE sign in the transom above it, and a white-bearded gentleman standing outside. Although the card never went through the mails, the date October 14, 1909 is

handwritten on the back.
The Port Elgin post
office was opened on

September 1, 1854 in Saugeen Township, Bruce County under the name **Normanton**, with A. H. Kennedy as postmaster. Its name was changed to **Port Elgin** on April Fool's Day 1874 (124 years ago to the day from when this is being written), when Mrs. Mary M. Roy was postmistress, as the position was then termed – she had succeeded her husband, Archibald Roy, in office.

The first postmarking device used at this office was a NORMANTON / U.C double broken circle; it has been observed in use from March 13, 1861 to May 22, 1873. A 21mm PORT·ELGIN / ONT broken circle was proofed on December 18, 1878; the only usage recorded is on October 6, 1880. It was followed by a device not in the proof impression books, a 20mm PORT ELGIN / ONT broken circle known used from September 4, 1899 to January 3, 1906. This in turn was followed by an 18½mm PORT ELGIN / ONT. broken circle proofed on September 26, 1910; the use of this last device recorded so far only extends from December 30, 1930 to August 10, 1931 – more data are needed to extend the known period of usage, which were taken from Bruce Graham's

listing, Ontario Broken Circle Postmarks by County: Early and Late Usage.

There are obvious gaps in the periods of usage noted here. For example, what postmark was used at Port Elgin from 1874 until the broken circle was proofed in 1878? Perhaps readers can supply the writer with further information on this subject, and on earlier or

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

[REF. R-012] MELANCTHON Post Office – Lew Metzger asks: "When did the District of Grey become Grey County? Was Melancthon Twp. annexed from Grey County or the District of Grey?" The first political connection of the territory that is now the County of Grey was with what was known as the Home District of Canada of which Toronto was the headquarters. From 1845 until the formation of the County, the Townships of Collingwood, Euphrasia, Artemesia, St. Vincent, Osprey and Proton were united politically with Simcoe. The remaining townships of "Grey" were united with the County of Wellington in the District of Waterloo. The provisional County of Grey was organized in 1852. In the years 1852-53 the provisional County of Grey was attached to the United Counties of Waterloo and Wellington. Having completed the construction of a County Court House and Jail, the County of Grey emerged with full status in January, 1854. The Melancthon Post Office was opened July 6, 1851. As such it opened in the District of Grey. Dufferin County was established January 24, 1881, having been formed out of Townships formerly belonging to the Counties of Simcoe, Grey and Wellington.

[REF. R-022] BARROW BAY Post Office –

Bruce Graham feels that the SINGLE BROKEN CIRCLE HAMMER proofed AP 2 1890 was the only single broken circle cancelling device used at this office. His records show usage from OC 31 1905 to JAN 19 1968. No CDS nor DUPLEX hammers have been seen. Covers *may* exist with a single line MOON number or a MOOD or MOTO cancel. The search is on, please report if you have seen any.

THE POSTAL HISTORY Camp Borden by Dave Hanes

In 1905, because of a lack of space at Niagara-on-the-Lake, surveyors were sent to examine the area south of the town of Angus, Ontario as a possible military site.


Protests from many sources halted the project and nothing further was done until 1916. At this time, the need for camp accommodation to train the large number of *Canadian Expeditionary Force* battalions became acute. Consequently, some 17,700 acres of the Sandy Plains area was taken over by the government.

A sprawling twenty-three square mile area of tree stumps and blowing sand became Camp Borden in May, 1916. The base site was named in

on the Army side; and a total of 3,272 trained aircrew on the Air side of Camp Borden.


When the Canadian Air Force was established in 1920, Camp Borden became its "School of Aviation" and air and ground training have been carried on without a break ever since. On April 1, 1924 the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) came into being. Camp Borden was the largest and busiest of the six Air Stations.

The RCAF School of Army Co-operation was formed during the period 1932-1936. About the same time, the


Machine-cancelled card CAMP BORDEN ONTARIO / FIELD POST OFFICE dated AUG 13 / 930 AM / 1916



The official opening of Camp Borden took place on July 11, 1916. The camp area was a mammoth tent city. Laid out in a long narrow area, it had a central main street about 2½ miles long with side streets running off at right angles, each about ½ mile in length.

Concurrent with the opening of Army Camp
Borden, the seed was being planted from which
Canada's Air Force would be born. A total of 850
acres of land were cleared of stumps, levelled and sown
with grass seed, located at the south end of the Army
Camp. Fifty-seven buildings were erected including fifteen
hangars. On May 5, 1917 the *Royal Flying Corps*(RFC) officially took over the new aerodrome at Borden.

When the armistice put a sudden stop to training in Canada, a total of thirty-six Battalions had been trained



Corps of Signals trained here for several years. Just prior to the Second World War, Camp Borden became the headquarters for training of the first armoured school. About the same time, other permanent schools began to make their appearance on the base. They were – Army Service Corps, School of Infantry, Army Medical Corps, Provost Corps, and the Dental Corps; as a result, Camp Borden became the most important training base in Canada.

The Post Office at Badjeros. Osprey Township, Grey County

adjeros is located in the southeast section of Osprey Township and Grey County. It was quite possibly the first hamlet to be established in Osprey Township when Philip Badjero erected the first tavern, having possession of lots 60 and 61 concessions 2 and 3. Originally Badjeros was on a small route from Maple



postal records show any information of a post office by that name in Grey County.

Little is known of the first 10 years in the life of the post office after its opening May 1,

1875. The Badjeros General Store & Post Office, as we know it today was built around 1886. This historic landmark was erected by Neil D. McKinnon who engaged James Potts as carpenter. Mr. McKinnon operated the store until he moved west around the turn of the century, selling it to George E. Bailey in 1904.



Valley to Dundalk with Taylor McLean and Ben Bauman, both being mail carriers. At one time mail was picked up coming south from McIntyre, then to Pott's Corners where the post office was in the house of Ed Potts, to Badjeros and on to Dundalk. Mr. James Gibson, clerk of the township, made the formal request for a post office, at which time the hamlet received its official name of *Snow Drift*. This it remained until Mr. Philip Badjero built on the 50 acres northeast of Badjeros. Peace, Plenty and Progress - A History of Osprey Township (1975) does not give any further information on the name Snow Drift, nor for how long the settlement remained with that name. None of the available

The subsequent owners were: Jacob Hamilton (1910-1937), Harry Sipprell (1937-1980), Dorothy Eadie Hannon (1980-1983), Bill and Merle Howes (1983-1989), Jacqueline Powers (1989-1996). Dianne Colgan is the present owner and postmistress of this historic post office.

cds cancel used until the end of 1989 (LKD 27 IX 89)



Bill Howes was the last postmaster to operate the Badjeros Post Office. He sold the store in October 1989 to Jacqueline Powers who took control of the post office in January 1990. I believe that the last three months of 1989 the operation was under the POCON 410462. As of January

1990 the postal structure was switched to a franchise (010502). Jacqueline Powers sold the store to Dianne Colgan in June 1996 and with the change in ownership a new franchise number was in order (252042). If this Badjeros situation is any indication then the post office dates really reflect when the final financial

statements were closed and not so much what the public sees as an opening and closing or change of ownership. Therefore the "earliest known dates" and "last known dates" become much more important. I have been fairly closely involved with the Badjeros



The original Canada Post list was dated February 10, 1993. This listing has been amended over the years. All such additions are printed in **BOLD**. The householder count refers to the number of drop-off points for each office. It is the number used for "Ad Mail" – all those pieces of printing that you never asked for but got just the same. This number is an excellent source to evaluate the size of the operation and the scarcity of postmarks.
